



Sevenoaks Town broke the history books last year after they reached the Fourth Qualifying Round of the FA Cup finally bowing out to Ebbsfleet United.

FA CUP FIXTURES ANNOUNCED AS SEVENOAKS TOWN FACE LINGFIELD

The Extra Preliminary Round and the Preliminary Round draws for this season's Emirates FA Cup have been made and we have four West Kent sides in action.

Based on last season's league placings, Sevenoaks Town will be Kent's highest ranking team taking part in the initial stage and Harry Hudson's side will start with a trip to Lingfield FC, who play at Horley Town FC.

Sevenoaks made club history in the FA Cup last season when they bowed out in the Fourth Qualifying round after a narrow defeat on the road at Vanarama National League South side Ebbsfleet United. after their heroics away at Bath City in the previous round.

Supporters and players alike will be hoping for another marvellous cup run

and it'll start probably on Sunday 6th August with their fixture against Lingfield, due to Horley Town also receiving a home fixture in the cup. Should they win then they will get a favourable home draw against Abbey Rangers or Colliers Wood United on August 19th.

Elsewhere, Tunbridge Wells will face Uxbridge at home, Rusthall travel to Lancing and Corinthian will host Bedfont Sports Club. Tunbridge Wells will face a tough trip to Corinthian Casuals in the next round should they win and Rusthall will be away at either Saltdean United or Badshot Lea. Corinthian will have another home tie should they win, this time against Herne Bay.

Ties are to be played over the weekend of August 5th/6th and August 19th/20th.
