ANGELS AND TOWN LIFT THE WEEKEND MOOD AFTER MIDWEEK SETBACKS

Tonbridge Angels and Sevenoaks Town both bounced back after suffering losses during the week, lifting the spirits of the sodden fans in the process.

Tonbridge had two Vanarama National League South away matches to contend with in just five days; first up was a short trip to Hampshire to face high flying Farnborough on Tuesday night where they were comfortably beaten 4-1. Jernade Meade scoring a consolation goal for the Angels in the 71st minute. Saturday saw the team leave Tonbridge at 6.30am for the 240 mile journey to Plymouth Parkway, the current home ground of Truro City FC. Goals from Sonny Fish (45'+2) and Lewis Gard (62' pen) saw Tonbridge lift

themselves up the league and into 15th position on 18 points after 15 games played.

Meanwhile, Tonbridge Angels have been drawn away in the second round of the FA Trophy against the winner of the Hythe Town versus Ramsgate tie, which is now rescheduled for Tuesday night after Saturday's game at Hythe was postponed.

Sevenoaks Town first suffered and then enjoyed a similar week to Tonbridge, losing away to Burgess Hill Town on Tuesday evening 1-0 before hosting Chichester City on Saturday afternoon. In a thrilling game, that saw just one goal and one yellow card, Sevenoaks came out on top after Rowan Liburd's 11th minute strike.

Town then dug deep to defend their lines and were rewarded at the final whistle with all three points. Amazingly in a game that didn't really have any melting points, there were 17 minutes of added time throughout the match.

The win puts Sevenoaks up to third in the Isthmian League South East Division, and with a bumper couple of months ahead, they will need performances and results like this to keep them in the title race.

- Elsewhere, the Kent County League confirms the withdrawal of Chipstead Football Club from the league's Premier Division. There is a lot of speculation regarding their withdrawal, and we will comment on it in the December issue of *West Kent Sport & Wellbeing* magazine.
