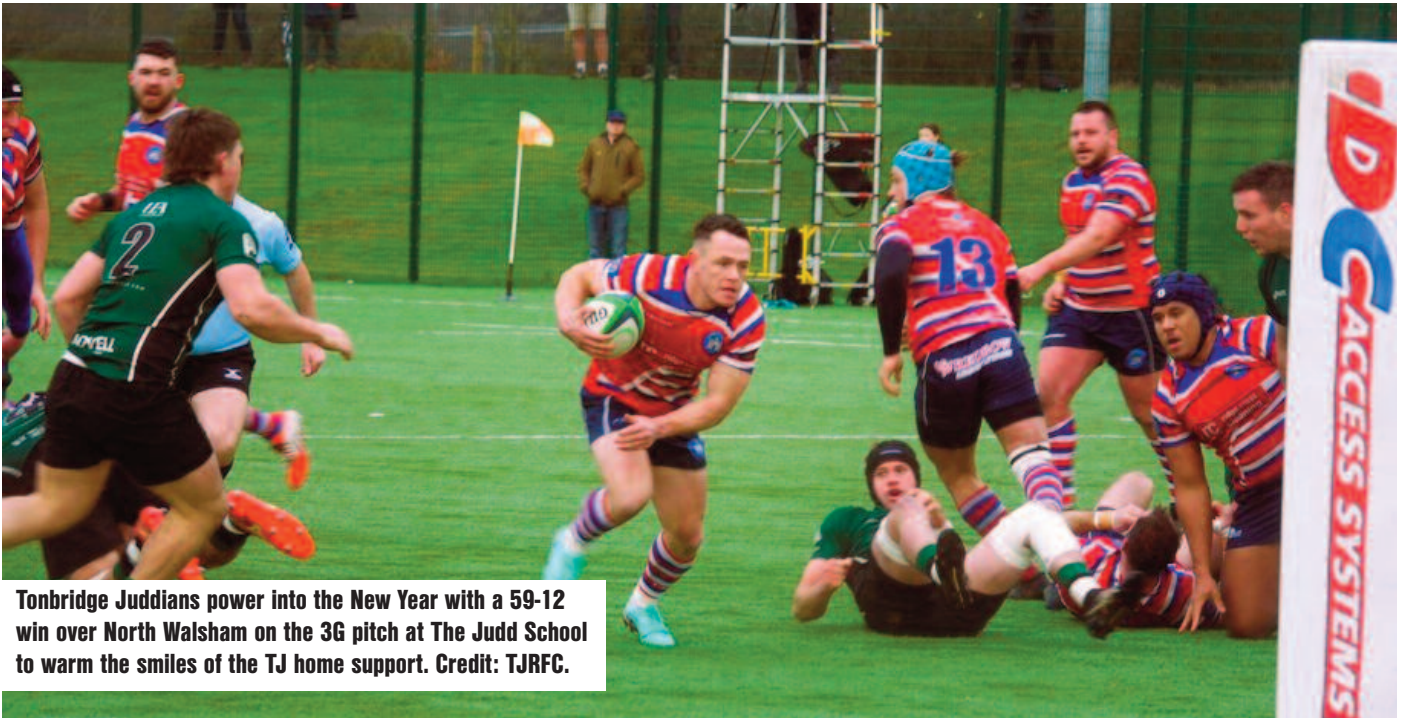

TONBRIDGE JUDDIANS AND SEVENOAKS MAKE PROGRESS IN NATIONAL 2 EAST

Tonbridge Juddians blew away the cobwebs on Saturday afternoon after a powerful first half display against North Walsham at the Vizards 3G at The Judd School in Tonbridge to ring in the New Year with a much needed win. Tonbridge went into the break with a 47-7 lead, thanks to a seven try first half haul which took the game quickly and powerfully away from the visitors. Tries from Matt Walsh, Tommy Nicoll, Ryan Munnely, Luke Talbot, Howard Packman, Duncan Tout and Alex Reid were topped off with four conversions from Tom White and two from Sam Evans. Talbot added a second try in the second half and Jack Whitmarsh danced over

the line in the final minutes with Evans converting once again to give a final score of 59-12 to the home side. Meanwhile, Sevenoaks hosted high flying Barnes at Knole Paddock to take their win tally to six for the season.

Last year Sevenoaks lost both matches against Barnes so your can imagine the supporters glee after turning them over 31-27 in the dying minutes of the match. Tries from Matthew McRae, Joshua Livett, Alexi Hickin (2), plus four conversions, and a penalty from Ben Adams secured the win for the Oaks and it consolidates their place in the National League 2 East most probably for another season. This weekend both teams are on the road as Tonbridge Juddians travel to Guernsey whilst Sevenoaks head north to Old Albanians. Juddians ladies will also travel to the Bailiwick of Guernsey on Saturday afternoon for a double header for the Tonbridge club.

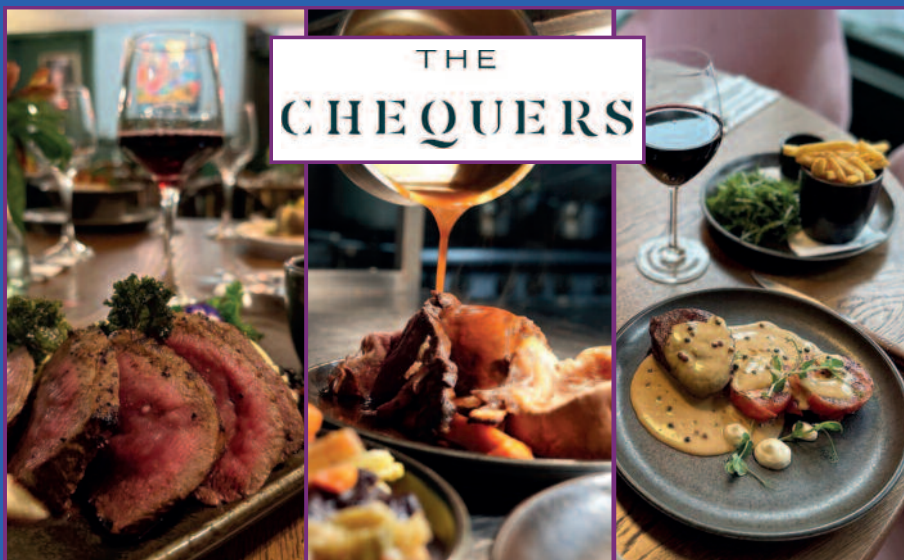
