CORINTHIAN LOSE CHALLENGE CUP FINAL ON PENALTIES

Corinthian Football Club were unlucky to lose the South East Counties Football League Challenge Cup Final on Good Friday, as they were finally beaten by virtue of spot kicks by Erith Town.

Corinthian opened the scoring in the 32nd minute after a moment of confusion between Erith's goalkeeper and defender allowed Matt Hagan to pass the ball into the back of the net for a 1-0 lead.

However, an 86th minute penalty was awarded to Erith Town and it was duly put away at the second time of asking, to take the tie straight to a penalty shootout. Unfortunately for Corinthian, it wasn't to be their day and a final penalty scoreline of 5-3 ensure Erith's success on the day.

WINNIFRITH SUCCESS IN POOL LEADS TO PARIS

Iona Winnifrith, a member of Tonbridge Swimming Club, has made waves at the Speedo Aquatics GB Swimming Championships 2024 finishing second in the Multi-Class 50m Butterfly with a time of 39.64s and a place at this year's Paralympics in Paris. Iona also took part in the Multi-Class 50m Breaststroke as the only competitor, however despite a winning time of 42.74s, which is just outside the European record, this discipline is not recognised at the Paralympics. Elsewhere, RTW Monson have both Fern Sneddon and Callie-Ann Warrington competing in the Multi-Class 50m Freestyle heats on Thursday morning, with the finals taking place later in the day.
